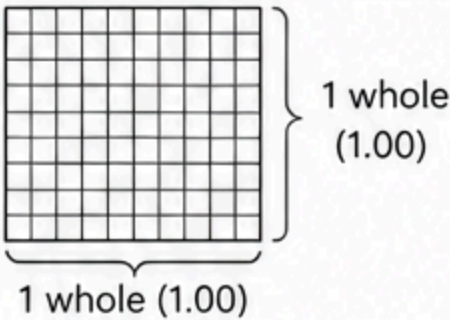


Shade Decimal Values on Grid Squares
